This sales agreement refers to a Welsh Springer Spaniel puppy whelped (Date:_____), sired by Ch. _____, Reg# _____ out of Ch _____, Reg # _____. This is a companion (pet) puppy who will be registered with an AKC Limited Registration. Limited Registration allows participation in official AKC obedience, tracking, agility, and hunting, but not conformation. This registration makes it ineligible for breeding. This puppy is being sold for the amount of \$_____.

Every effort has been made to breed a healthy dog from sound and healthy stock. Development of hip dysplasia, epilepsy, eye problems or other health problems can not be predicted by the breeders at the time of sale. The breeder makes no guarantees regarding any hereditary or congenital defects of the puppy not noted on the health certificate. Should the dog develop epilepsy or hip dysplasia severe enough to require euthanasia before _______ (the time at which the dog would be 2 years of age), a full refund of the purchase price or replacement of the dog with one of similar quality from a litter of 4 or more, shall be made after receipt of veterinary proof of euthanasia. The decision regarding refund or replacement rests with the buyer, but is dependent upon breeding plans of the breeder. The buyer may choose the next available litter, or may wait up to three years. After three years, replacing the puppy will be at the discretion of the seller.

The buyer agrees to have this dog examined by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of pickup, and if any unsoundness is noted at that time the buyer should immediately contact the breeder. The breeder agrees to refund the full purchase price of the dog if the buyers return the dog within 7 days of pickup, provided it is returned in the same condition as it was on the date of sale. Should the condition of the dog upon return warrant veterinary care, the cost of such care will be deducted from the amount to be refunded. Any cost to return the dog to the breeders will be borne by the buyer.

The buyer agrees to have this dog receive all normal vaccines and veterinary medical care, including heartworm and parvovirus preventatives, and Lyme's disease vaccine in endemic areas. The buyer agrees not to use the animal for breeding purposes. It is understood that this agreement is an attempt to protect the Welsh Springer Spaniel and the integrity of the seller's bloodlines. Spaying/neutering should be done at the time of your veteranarian's choosing. Any expenses associated with neutering the dog or providing ongoing medical care are to be borne by the buyer. The buyer agrees to promptly notify the breeders of any health problems this dog may develop, so that proper breeding records are maintained.

This dog is being sold with the intention of providing companionship to the buyer for the rest of the dog's natural life. The buyer agrees to provide proper in home care for this puppy. This dog is not to be kept outside in a pen, or dog house, or on a chain, but to live in the house with it's family. The buyer agrees to see that the dog has proper exercise, medical care, training, proper emotional care (love) and socialization to allow the puppy to grow up to be a healthy well adjusted companion animal.

Should the buyer not be able to keep the puppy for any reason, the puppy, it's signed AKC Registration papers, and health information including rabies certificate and tag are to be returned to the breeder. The breeder will give to the buyer any money from resale of the puppy, less any cost accrued to the seller due to the dog's return. The dog is not to be placed with a third party or animal shelter under any circumstances.

Should the buyer fail to abide by any requirements of this contract, including failure to properly care for the dog, or failure to contact the breeders for rehousing, then all terms of this contract regarding replacement, or refund are to be considered void.

This dog is to be registered with the AKC using the "Aurora" prefix.

This dog has an Avid microchip which provides lifetime identification of the dog.

The remainder of purchase price is due when the puppy is picked up. The deposit will only be refunded if the breeder is unable to provide the buyer with a puppy.
